

David Goode is Organist at Eton College, where he teaches some of the UK's most talented young organists, combining this post with a flourishing performing career. He was Sub-Organist at Christ Church, Oxford from 1996-2001 and won major prizes at the 1997 St. Alban's and 1998 Calgary Competitions. From 2003-5 he was Organist-in-Residence at First Congregational Church of Los Angeles. He has been a regular presence at the BBC Proms since 1999 and made his RFH debut in 2002, and has played all over Europe, the US and the Far East. He has appeared with several of the UK's top orchestras; he also has an established partnership with trumpeter Alison Balsom. Amongst numerous recordings over a quarter-century, his set of Bach's complete works for Signum Records is being released in full this November; he is also known for his interpretation of Reger's music.
